

## ACADEMICS (PG & PN)

### HEALTHY SANDWICH MAKING

Tasty treat activity was organized for our little ones. Children of Baby birdies did delicious and yummy activity of Sandwich Making. Children were given different type of ingredients like - Onion, Tomato, Cucumber, Mayonnaise, Salt and Bread. They followed the steps and made yummy sandwiches by applying mayonnaise on the breads and putting the yummy veggies and salt on it. Different flashcards of Kitchen utensil like - Spoon, Whisker, Rolling pin etc.



### TALL AND SHORT

When we talk about "tall" and "short" in pre-number or preschool math, we're discussing one of the first and most intuitive ways children of Hilly billies learn to compare objects. Here's why this concept is essential in everyday life and early education

**What Tall and Short Mean**

**Tall:** An object that has a greater height compared to another.

**Short:** An object that has a smaller height when placed side by side. It's Important for Kids for foundation of measurement learning "tall" versus "short"; helps children grasp basic measurement concepts - understanding size, length, and spatial relationships, which leads to later skills like using rulers.

### RAINY DAY FUN

The children of Star Hunters enjoyed a delightful hands-on activity on the theme “Rainy Day Fun.” They enthusiastically participated in activities like sailing paper boats and joyfully jumping in puddles while wearing their raincoats. The little ones were also introduced to rainy-day essentials such as raincoats, gumboots, and umbrellas. To make the concept more engaging, the teacher demonstrated how to keep ourselves safe and dry during the rainy season.

It was a fun-filled and informative experience that helped children learn about rainy-day habits in a playful and interactive way.



### WORLD OF INSECTS

Our little learners from Rising Stars were introduced to the world of insects through two fascinating friends – the Ladybug and the Honeybee. The Ladybug, with its bright red wings and black spots, loves to rest on leaves and flowers. The Honeybee, with its yellow and black stripes, works hard to collect nectar and make sweet honey in its hive. To make learning joyful, children participated in an engaging activity – “Take Me to My Home” – where they guided the ladybug and honeybee back to their respective homes. This hands-on experience helped children connect with nature while learning about the importance of these tiny creatures.

## ALL ABOUT FARM ANIMALS

**Washing Farm Animals** - A Fun Sensory Experience! As part of our ongoing efforts to make learning interactive and joyful, Star Hunters class participated in an engaging sensory activity. Children of Star hunters had a delightful time pretending to clean their favorite farm animals using soap bubbles and using sponges. The activity was set up with toy animals placed in shallow tubs of soapy water, giving little hands the chance to scrub, rinse after picking up from the muddy place. This sensory-rich experience offered much more than just fun. It supported the development of fine motor skills as children used sponges and brushes to grip, squeeze, and scrub. The texture of water and soap also stimulated their sense of touch, while the pretend-play element encouraged imagination and role play.



## TOUCH AND FEEL (Montessori)

Our curious toddlers from Feather faces explored the fascinating world of textures through the Touch and Feel Box activity in the Montessori class. The little ones were excited to discover and describe different materials such as soft feathers, smooth pebbles, and delicate flower petals. This sensory experience encouraged them to use their sense of touch to compare, identify, and express how each object felt. The activity not only enhanced their sensory awareness but also helped develop vocabulary and cognitive skills — making learning both fun and meaningful!



## ACADEMICS (PG & PN)

### WORLD OF ANIMALS

Learning about animals is an essential part of connecting with nature. Exploring the Animal Kingdom The children learned about different types of animals, including Wild, Water, and Domestic animals. With curiosity and enthusiasm, children of Rainbow rompers participated in interactive activities that helped them differentiate between these animal groups. The highlight of the day was our fun-filled activity where kids joyfully placed animals like lions, dolphins, and dogs into their corresponding boxes - Water Animals, Wild Animals, and Domestic Animals. This engaging exercise not only promoted learning but also enhanced their focus and concentration.



## ACADEMICS (PRE-PRIMARY & PRIMARY)

### LETTER RECOGNITION

This engaging activity is designed for Nursery children to learn letter sounds through play - based learning. Using alphabet cards children identified and matched letters cards with the letters in the fish.



## LEARNING MATH FUN WAY!

Our little mathematicians from KG class explored the concept of Tens and Ones with colorful LEGO blocks. They built towers of 10 and single blocks for ones, making counting and place value exciting and hands-on. This activity helped them visualize numbers, strengthen their counting skills, and understand how tens and ones form bigger numbers!



## PATTERNMAKING

Class 1 students enjoyed a fun math's activity on patterns and shapes. They were given three different options of colorful designs and their task was to recreate the same pattern using cut-out pieces.

**This activity helped children:**

- Recognize and match shapes
- Observe patterns carefully
- Improve fine motor skills
- Boost concentration and creativity

The little ones had a great time arranging the pieces to form the correct design while learning the concept of visual recognition and spatial understanding in a playful way.

## REINFORCEMENT OF ADJECTIVES

Reinforcement of Adjectives was done in Grade 2 through an activity. Children were told to pick up an object and describe it using Adjectives. Using adjectives to describe the object helped children develop their vocabulary and language skills. They were also told to Draw and colour the object. Such activities allow children to express their creativity.



## FINDING VERBS

To strengthen their understanding of verbs, Grade 3 students engaged in an interactive finding the Verb activity. Each child was given a kids' newspaper and tasked with reading an article, identifying, and highlighting all the verbs they encountered.
