ACADEMICS (PG & PN)

CLEAN TEETH HEALTHY TEETH

Little babies of Our Aadyant School enjoyed doing healthy teeth activity.

DRESS ME UP

The little learners of Rainbow Rompers had a fun-filled and engaging learning experience through the "My body puzzle" and "Dress Me Up" activities. Children enthusiastically explored body parts by stacking and arranging cubes to form a complete human figure, helping them understand body structure in a playful way. This hands-on activity not only strengthened their fine motor skills and hand-eye coordination but also encouraged problem-solving and concentration. Adding to the excitement, the "Dress Me Up" activity allowed children to creatively dress the figure, enhancing their imagination and sense of independence. It was a delightful session where learning and fun went hand in hand, leaving the children curious, confident, and happy.

ACADEMICS (PG & PN)

BIG AND SMALL

Big and small are words we use to compare the size of things. A big object takes up more space, while a small object takes up less space. For example, an elephant is big, and an ant is small. The bus is big, and the bicycle is small. We can see big and small things all around us. Learning about big and small helped children of Hilly Billies to understand and compare objects in their daily life.



LEMONADE MAKING

Lemonade Making Activity for Hilly Billies children was a sensory-rich, summer-themed activity where they learned to make a healthy, refreshing drink by squeezing lemons, mixing water, and adding sugar. This activity enhances fine motor skills, teaches concepts like sour vs. sweet, and promotes teamwork while exploring yellow color and lemon shapes.

SORTING OF COLOURS

Colour sorting is an interesting and engaging activity for kids. This activity builds visual discrimination, fine motor coordination, logical thinking, and early math concepts. Our tiny toddlers at Feather Faces were very excited to do this hands-on play activity. There are three primary colours: red, yellow, and blue. They are used to create secondary colours like orange, which is made by mixing red and yellow. In this activity, children sorted red and yellow coloured balls into two different baskets. It was a play-based activity full of excitement and fun. The children of Feather Faces enjoyed identifying and sorting the red and yellow colours.



SOUND REVISION

Sound revision is an important part of early childhood learning. It helps children recall and strengthen the letter sounds they have already learned. Through regular revision, children become more confident in recognizing sounds and connecting them with letters. Teachers use fun and engaging methods such as flashcards, songs, actions, and games to revise sounds. Activities like identifying beginning sounds, matching objects to their sounds, and repeating phonetic patterns make learning enjoyable and effective. Sound revision not only improves memory but also builds a strong foundation for reading and writing. It encourages children to listen carefully, speak clearly, and develop early literacy skills in a playful way.

Consistent practice and positive reinforcement help children master sounds at their own pace, making learning both meaningful and enjoyable.



SENSE ORGANS

Sense organs activities help toddlers explore the world around them in a fun and meaningful way. Through simple hands-on experiences, children learn to use their five senses — sight, hearing, smell, taste, and touch. Activities like feeling different textures, listening to sounds, smelling flowers, tasting safe food items, and identifying colourful objects encourage curiosity and observation skills. These activities also support language development, sensory awareness, fine motor skills, and cognitive growth. Learning through the senses makes playtime enjoyable while helping toddlers understand and connect with their environment.



ACADEMICS (PRE-PRIMARY & PRIMARY)

ALPHABET MATCH-UP

Learning made fun and interactive! Our little learners from Kindergarten enjoyed matching uppercase and lowercase letters, boosting their letter recognition and fine motor skills. Through this engaging Alphabet Match-Up activity, children explored letters in a playful way while building confidence and focus.



NUMBER NINJA

Our tiny number ninjas from Kindergarten rolled the dice, counted the dots carefully, tossed colorful pom-poms onto the sheet, and circled the exact number they got! This playful hands-on activity turned learning numbers into an exciting game while boosting counting skills, concentration, and fine motor development in the most fun way.

ADDITION IS FUN

Class 1 little learners explored addition in a fun, hands-on way! Using pom-poms and number tubes, they counted, combined, and discovered how numbers come together. Learning maths has never been this exciting and engaging!



शब्द-श्रृंखला गतिविधि

COMMON NOUNS

The concept of Common nouns was taught to Grade 2 through an activity. First the teacher explained that a common noun is the general name of a person, place, animal or a thing. Then the children were told to identify the common nouns in their classroom.

After that they were told to draw four common nouns that they see daily in the classroom and label them.

SOLUBLE & INSOLUBLE

Grade 3 students enjoyed a fun science experiment on soluble and insoluble substances. They mixed different items in water and carefully observed which materials dissolved and which stayed unchanged.



संयुक्त व्यंजन

कक्षा 4 के विद्यार्थियों ने संयुक्त व्यंजन पर एक रोचक गतिविधि की। इस गतिविधि में मेज़ पर संयुक्त व्यंजन के अक्षरों के उदाहरण शब्द लिखकर रखे गए थे। बोर्ड पर विषय -व्यंजन, संयुक्त व्यंजन उसकी परिभाषा और संयुक्त व्यंजन के अक्षर के साथ लिखकर बोर्ड पर चिपकाया हुआ था। बच्चों को मेज़ से संयुक्त व्यंजन के अक्षर के एक उदाहरण को चुनना था और उसे पढ़कर उपयुक्त संयुक्त व्यंजन के उदाहरण के चित्र के सामने चिपकाना था। इस गतिविधि के माध्यम से बच्चों ने संयुक्त व्यंजन वाले अक्षरों की पहचान की तथा उसके उदाहरण का उचित प्रयोग करना सीखा। बच्चों ने अपने सोचने की क्षमता और पहचानने की शक्ति का विकास किया। इस क्रिया से उनमें आत्मविश्वास भी बढ़ा।



वाक्य रचना

कक्षा 5 के विद्यार्थियों ने वाक्य पर एक रोचक गतिविधि की। इस गतिविधि में मेज़ पर कुछ वाक्य के भेदों के उदाहरण वाक्य लिखकर रखे गए थे। बोर्ड पर विषय -वाक्य उसकी परिभाषा, उदाहरण और उसके भेदों के नाम के साथ लिखकर एक चार्ट पर चिपकाया हुआ था। बच्चों को मेज़ से एक उदाहरण वाक्य को चुनना था और उसे पढ़कर उपयुक्त वाक्य भेद के सामने चिपकाना था। इस गतिविधि के माध्यम से बच्चों ने वाक्य के भेदों की पहचान की तथा उसके उदाहरण का उचित प्रयोग करना सीखा। बच्चों ने अपने सोचने की क्षमता और पहचानने की शक्ति का विकास किया। इस क्रिया से उनमें आत्मविश्वास भी बढ़ा।
